Collagen Sheets

Primary Dressing

Sterile, single-use dressings composed of purified collagen. Designed to help manage partial and full-thickness wounds by maintaining a moist wound environment that supports the body's natural healing processes. These sheets conform well to flat wound beds and may be used on chronic ulcers, surgical sites, and other slow-healing wounds.

Collagen Powder

Primary Dressing

Sterile collagen powder intended for use on lightly to moderately exuding wounds. Supports a moist wound environment that facilitates the body's normal healing response. Conforms to wound contours and may be used in tunneling or irregular wound beds. Single-use only. Suitable for ulcers, surgical wounds, and partial-thickness injuries as directed by clinical judgment.

Non-adherent Layer

Protect the wound with a non-stick layer.

Super Absorbent, Hydrocapillary Layer

A wound care dressing designed to rapidly promote healing in acute/chronic wounds.

Calcium Alginate Dressings

Primary Dressing

Highly absorbent wound dressings made from natural alginate fibers. On contact with wound exudate, the dressing forms a soft gel that helps maintain a moist wound environment. Intended for use on moderate to heavily draining wounds including ulcers, donor sites, and pressure injuries. Conforms easily to wound contours and may be used under compression as directed.

Silver Alginate Dressings

Primary Dressing

Alginate dressings that contain ionic silver. Designed to absorb moderate to heavy exudate while helping to manage the wound environment. Appropriate for wounds that are at risk of infection or have signs of local contamination. Helps support a clean wound bed while maintaining moisture balance.

Bordered Gauze Dressings

Tertiary Dressing

Sterile adhesive dressings with a soft, absorbent center pad and breathable backing. The gentle adhesive border secures the dressing in place while protecting periwound skin. Designed for wounds with light to moderate drainage, including surgical incisions and skin tears. Water-resistant outer layer provides added protection from external moisture.

Tertiary Dressing
